All materials must be postmarked no later than **April 23, 2013**.

PLEASE NOTE that if your high school/teachers/counselors will be mailing out official high school transcripts and/or letters of recommendation separately from your application, it is *your* responsibility to notify them in advance of the deadline date and to follow-up with them in order to ensure that all application materials are <u>mailed out and post-marked no later than April 23, 2013. Incomplete or late applications will otherwise NOT be considered.</u> (If you are notified of your admission to the University after March 1, 2013 and you need to extend the deadline for your application, please contact me directly at 516-489-4390).

All scholarship applicants will be required to participate in an interview with a Scholarship Committee member, which will be held in the New York metropolitan area. The Scholarship Committee will endeavor to notify the scholarship *recipient(s)* only on or about May 31, 2013. One scholarship winner and two alternates will be selected by the Scholarship Committee and notified as soon as possible of the results. A Scholarship Award Dinner & Ceremony will be held on or about June 12, 2013 in Manhattan and the winner and alternates are *highly encouraged* to attend.

Scholarship awards will be paid directly to the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign and scholarship recipients will be credited upon registering for the Fall Semester (50% of the scholarship will credited to the recipient in the Fall semester, and the remaining 50% of the scholarship will credited to the recipient in the Spring semester).
